He joined the Nuclear Protection Evaluation Centre (CEPN), a non-profit organization for research and studies in the evaluation of the technical, health, economic and societal dimensions of radiological protection in 1977 and was the director of the Centre from 1989 to 2016. Since the early nineties he has been actively involved in the rehabilitation of the living conditions of the affected population after a nuclear accident, first in Belarus in the context of the management of the long-term consequences of the Chernobyl accident, then in Japan in relation to the Fukushima accident.
